**Dane County Farmer's Market Showcases Breakfast Cuisine by Chef
Tory Miller and His Students**

L'Etoile's Chef and Young Chef de Cuisines Create Excellent Early Morning Fare!

MADISON, WI (Feb. 9, 2009) --- Chef Tory Miller of L'Etoile Restaurant has enjoyed teaching young students about healthy eating, cooking and gardening for several years. Now visitors to the Dane County Indoor Farmer's Market on March 14 and 21 can savor his efforts and the students' culinary skills. On those Saturdays students will cook breakfast with chef Tory and help serve the meal. Students from the 8th grade at Sherman Middle School will cook on the 14th, and on the 21st, student chefs will be from Shabazz High School. The indoor Farmer's Market is located in the Madison Senior Center at 330 West Mifflin St. Breakfast is served from 8:30 to 11:00 a.m. and is \$7 per person and includes a beverage.

Sherman Middle School students and chef Tory will be serving waffles, cheese grits and fried chicken on March 14, but the final menu is always determined by the freshest ingredients available. The Shabazz students and the chef are still in the process of creating their breakfast menu. Each Saturday, chef Tory will have six or seven students cook and serve for an hour, before a new "crew" takes over. This schedule allows more young budding chefs to participate!

Chef Tory has been involved at the middle school level through his Sherman Garden Project which is in its first year of operation and was started by the chef with help from his wife, Lili. It serves several educational purposes - from showing children how to grow and use vegetables, to serving as an outdoor classroom for hands-on learning in science and math classes. Chef Tory began his involvement with the school several years ago through his work with C.H.O.W. - Choosing Healthy Options for Wisconsin - a program which teaches healthy eating strategies to school children. Chef Tory has also taught cooking classes at Shabazz High School and has been involved with an after school cooking club.

L'Etoile is a fine dining restaurant that offers French-inspired dishes which are seasonally based and support the products and produce of artisans and small sustainable farms of the Midwest.
